



Sea World Field Trip Frequently Asked Questions



SeaWorld One Day Ticket on January 24th

- Q** Are there group activities or tours on January 24th?
- A** No. This ticket gives you the freedom to explore the park at your own pace as a family.
- Q** Is there a parking fee?
- A** Yes. The parking fee is \$30.00 per car.
- Q** What if we are late?
- A** If you are late you may have to wait at the front entrance until someone is able to come back and give you your tickets.



Sleepover Experience January 23rd

- Q** Can I bring an air mattress?
- A** SeaWorld will provide a mat for every participant. You may bring your own mat or air mattress. Air mattress must be self inflatable, as outlets are not guaranteed. Any mat or air mattress must not be larger than a twin mattress.
- Q** Can parents or siblings come to sleepover experience?
- A** Parents are welcome, but there is a limit of one adult per student. Siblings 2nd grade and older may also sleepover.
- Q** Are there food allergy alternatives?
- A** The only pizza alternative provided is a nut free butter and jelly sandwich on gluten free bread. If you have food allergies, you may bring your own food in a small soft sided lunch box.
- Q** Is there a parking fee?
- A** You will pay a \$30 parking fee when you arrive on the 23rd. This parking fee will be good through the 24th (no additional fee the next day).



- Q** Do I need to attend the sleepover experience with my student?
- A** All parents are encouraged to attend the sleepover experience with their student. If a parent opts to not attend, they must coordinate with another CCA parent to be a chaperone for their student.
- Q** Additional Packing Instructions?
- A** You will need to carry all your belonging through the park. It is suggested you pack what you need in a suitcase with wheels. Do not bring a suitcase any larger than a standard carry on size. There will be a bathroom, but no showers. Bring clothing layers incase you are hot or cold throughout the night. Plan to wear modest and appropriate night clothes. Bring toiletries. Pack this years CCA t-shirt and dress down approved bottoms to wear through the park the next day.
